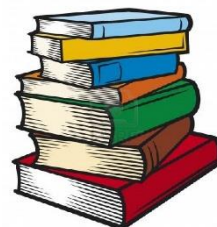
### **FREE SCHOOL MEALS**

If you think you may be entitled to Free School Meals please contact school for an application form. If you receive any of the following you may be entitled:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit\* and have an annual household income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190
- Universal Credit
